Dear Parents / Guardians of Third Grade Students,

The students in grade 3 will begin taking the *New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA)* on April 9, 2019. Students will complete two units of English Language Arts, and three units of Mathematics, which begins on April 8th and concludes on Friday, May 31, 2019.

Testing will begin promptly at 8:50 am daily. Therefore, it is extremely important that your child reports to school every day by 8:30 am, so that he/she can prepare for a timely start. Students who arrive late will not be permitted to enter the testing site.

The testing schedule for our third grade students is as follows:

Friday, May 10th – Unit 3 Math


You can help your child to perform his/her very best by doing the following:
