CLASSROOM DISCIPLINE PLAN

All students are expected to comply with the following five classroom rules:

4. Respect your teacher and peers' property, space, and time. (Words or actions intended to cause harm or distractions to learning will not be allowed.)

POSITIVE RECOGNITION

Positive actions of students will be recognized. Good behavior and academic performance will be noted by actions such as the following:

- Verbal praise
- Positive notes/postcards home
- Phone call home
- Individual rewards
- Class-wide rewards

CONSEQUENCES

Violations of the rules will lead to progressive discipline steps outlined below. These suggestions are provided to assist you in utilizing proactive intervention techniques before referring students to the Discipline Office. You may use these interventions as you see fit to assist the student in self-correcting behavior. If it is necessary to write a Discipline Referral, please ensure that it is fully completed. Also, students cannot be sent to the Discipline Office without a referral.

- A verbal warning is issued to the student
- Conference with the student
- Change the student's seat
- Assign your detention before school or after school
- Notify parent/guardian about detentions
- Schedule a conference with the parent
- Consult guidance counselor and/or social worker
- Discipline referral (After utilizing other strategies to correct behavior)
